In February, four members of the Leadership Team attended the CDM (formally CE&P) Leadership Conference in Atlanta.

Our Spring Gathering was held at Chapin Presbyterian Church on March 15. Praise and worship was followed by a short business meeting and then our ladies enjoyed our keynote speaker, Frankie Watson. Her theme was “Serving with Joy, A Journey of Grace.” Our ladies also attended a breakout session of their choice led by women of our Presbytery. An offering of \$982.00 was given to R.U.F. ministries in Palmetto Presbytery. There were 101 ladies in attendance representing 15 churches.

On October 3-5 the Fall Retreat was held at Crown Reef Beach Resort in Myrtle Beach with Sarah Ivill as our speaker. Her theme was “Let the One Who Is Thirsty Come”, a study of Revelation. The wonderfully talented ladies of Redeemer Presbyterian, Charleston led the worship music which helped us all to honor and glorify God. Our ladies took advantage of the opportunity to become better equipped with resources that the CDM (PCA) Bookstore brought to our Retreat. There were 244 women who attended from 22 churches. An offering of \$1404.55 was given to Ridge Haven, our PCA Camp and Conference grounds.
